  - Website
- Volunteer at an event
- Promote GNOME to others
- Fix a page on live.gnome.org (GNOME wiki)
- Become a trainee or junior developer
- Take part in an initiative

# GNOME Outreach Program for Women

- Three month internship, twice per year (northern and southern hemisphere summer)
- \$5000 stipend, as Google Summer of Code
- Not restricted to programming
  - Documentation, translation, marketing and artwork projects have been accepted
